

Bagaj: boyut ve ağırlı sınırlamaları

You have chosen your destination and bought a flight ticket... but what about the luggage? You should check the airline's baggage, size and weight limitations before you prepare your luggage.

What are the dimensions of the registered baggage? What is the weight of the hand luggage allowed in the cabin? The airline applies its own policies regarding the amount, weight and number of baggage allowed, so you should always check your baggage allowance before your flight. Otherwise, the cost of flights may be higher than expected.

Hand luggage dimensions

Hand baggage sizes may vary between **low-fare airlines** . For example, the luggage size limits imposed by Ryanair are almost the same as Wizz Air, but there are a few centimeters difference. Although it does not seem important, it may cause problems at check-in - if your hand baggage exceeds certain limits, you may be put on hold and have to pay a large fee.

In general, your cabin baggage must fit under the seat in front of you or on the top shelves. Each carrier **has its own policy regarding the size and weight of the hand luggage** . **Hand luggage dimensions** , handles, pockets, wheels and so on. You should also remember that it contains any bits that come out. Generally, your **carrying case should not weigh more than 8-10 kg** .

Dimensions of registered baggage

If you are not satisfied with the airline **cabin baggage restrictions** , you can purchase registered baggage (which is in the lower baggage handling section of the aircraft). The size and weight must meet the requirements of your airline, but the important thing is the amount of baggage that must be collected. The number of items you can put in your luggage depends on the class of travel. The final price is determined by various factors such as the number of bags, their weight, your flight dates (in high season, the price will be higher) and the route.

Which suitcase should you buy?

A number of factors must be considered if you want to be informed about the right suitcase to travel. First of all, you should check the airline's policy regarding the size and weight of your baggage. Think about how often you fly. Occasional travelers may choose a little cheaper bags or shoes, but frequent flyers who travel several times a month should choose a high-quality hard shell suitcase.

A wide range of luggage is available on the market up to a versatile, soft surface (make sure your luggage is equipped with a lock system and rotating wheels). Which would be best? If you're looking for a cabin bag, choose a soft backpack-style suitcase - it's easier to fill the compartment from the top. Soft shoulder bags or backpacks are easier to squeeze. You can also choose semi-rigid suitcases that provide more protection for your belongings. However, their disadvantage is that they are slightly heavier.

If you are traveling with a registered baggage, it is better to choose a hard shell suitcase because it is less fragile (we do not need to tell you how the baggage handling personnel at the airport have put the bags on the plane). The best option would be rigid luggage made of polycarbonate with corner protection reinforcement for extra protection. You can also protect your valuables with a TSA lock or padlock for your bag.
